92-94+ Points 2013 CORLEY Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon - Nov 2016

The color is almost black as a moonless night, the wine full-bodied and rich, showing loads of blueberry and blackberry fruit, judicious use of oak, impressive purity and texture. This could be best wine from Monticello Vineyards in many years.

91-94 Points 2013 CORLEY Tietjen Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - Jan 2017

The 2013 Tietjen Vineyard is black ruby/purple color, is also impressive with loads of blueberry and blackberry fruit, graphite and forest floor. It's full bodied, rich and should be impressive.
100% Cabernet Sauvignon

91-93 Points 2013 CORLEY State Lane Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - Sep 2016

As for the 2013 State Lane Vineyard, this wine reveals outstanding finesse, richness, licorice, graphite, blackberry and cassis. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

90-92 Points 2013 CORLEY Yewell Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon - Mar 2017

The 2013 Yewell Vineyard, this is from a site in St. Helena, and like the State Lane and Tietjen is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and will also see a full 30 mon- barrel aging. It shows sweet cassis fruit, plenty of toasty oak, a big full-bodied mouthfeel and lots of texture.
